If we fill before the closing date, we will maintain a waiting list to fill any cancellations.

### Awards

Rosettes will be awarded for High in Trial, High Combined and **Triple Crown** (HS qualifying in AGI, AGII and AGIII). Placement rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place qualifying dogs in each class in each trial. All qualifying scores will receive qualifying ribbons. New Title ribbons will be available. **Please let the trial secretary know if there is a possibility that you will earn a UGRACH or an additional UGRACH and we will make a title jump bar available for you.**

## Overnight Lodging

## Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is of primary importance. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all of the obstacles safely.
- Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area. Handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial judge and/or trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Please be considerate of others and **clean up after your dog** at the trial site and motel facilities. **Owners/handlers not cleaning up after their dogs are subject to dismissal from the trial without refund.**
- **The Judge is not required wait for any dog holding up the judging of a class.**
- Incorrect / incomplete entries, late entries or entries received without the appropriate fees will not be accepted. They will be returned to the sender via U.S. Mail. (Minor questions may be handled by telephone if the entrant has indicated on the entry form that he/she will accept collect calls or by email if the entrant provides an address.)
- After the trial closes, no refunds will be given except for bitches in season. In this case, a Veterinarian's certificate will be required and a \$5.00 handling fee will be assessed.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed on the show grounds during the trial weekend, Saturday & Sunday, June 6 & 7.
- **NO** Alcohol, illegal drugs, or **SMOKING** permitted on these grounds. Confine smoking to the parking lot.

## Directions to Trial Site

**From Northern Virginia** – Use the Greenway (VA 267 West) towards Leesburg (toll road). At the end of the toll road, take Exit 1A on the left towards Leesburg/Warrenton onto Route 7 West. Go 9.3 miles and take the VA 287 exit towards Purcellville. Turn left onto Berlin Turnpike, then right onto E Main St. Go about .7 mi to trial site on the right in a shopping center. Alternative; use Route 7 West, then follow directions above from Leesburg.

**From Richmond, VA & Points South and East** – Take I95 north to I495 north (Capitol Beltway) towards Tysons Corner. At exit 45 on the LEFT, merge onto VA 267 West (Dulles toll road) towards Leesburg/Warrenton. Stay on the toll road to Leesburg (Greenway). At the end of the toll road, take Exit 1A on the left towards Leesburg/Warrenton onto Route 7 West. Go 9.3 miles and take the VA 287 exit towards Purcellville. Turn left onto Berlin Turnpike, then right onto E Main St. Go about .7 mi to trial site on the right in a shopping center.

**From Frederick, MD** – Take US Route 15 south and cross into Virginia. Get on the Route 15/Route 7 Bypass around Leesburg, then take Route 7 West. From Route 7 West, take the VA 287 exit towards Purcellville. Turn left onto Berlin Turnpike, then right onto E Main St. Go about .7 mi to trial site on the right in a shopping center.

**The trial site is in a shopping center** – There is plenty of parking in front of the building and to the side of the building.

**There is no overnight parking at the facility.**

**Food** - There are plenty of fast-food restaurants in the vicinity. Restrooms are indoors at the DGOTC building..

**The ring is double-fenced and there is plenty of space inside the DGOTC building for crating.**

## About the Trial

On Saturday & Sunday, June 6 & 7, 2009, the Mattaponi Agility Dogs and Dulles Gateway Obedience Training Club, Inc, will hold 4 agility trials under the regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc (August. 2005 Official Rules. These off-lead trials are open to all UKC registered dogs that are six months of age or older. Agility I, II and III titling classes will be offered. Entry in the Agility II class is open to dogs with or without the Agility I title. A dog may be entered in the Agility I and Agility II classes at the same trial. Entry in the Agility III Class is open only to those dogs that have completed the requirements for the United Agility Champion title (UACH).

The Agility I and Agility II classes will be split into two sections, A and B. The Agility I-A class (AGI-A) will be open to dogs that have not earned a UKC UAGI title. The Agility I-B class (AGI-B) will be open to all dogs. Agility II-A class (AGII-A) will be open to dogs that have not earned a UKC UAGII title. The Agility II-B class (AGII-B) will be open to all dogs. All points toward the United Agility Champion title (UACH) must be earned from the Agility I-B and the Agility II-B classes. All points towards United Grand Agility Champion (UGRACH) must be earned from Agility I-B, Agility II-B, and Agility III classes.

No on-leash course familiarization will be allowed for any dogs entered in Agility I-B, Agility II-B, and Agility III classes

## To Enter

To enter, send a completed copy of the UKC entry form (or a copy thereof), and a check or money order. Entries close at 6:00 PM on May 22, 2009 at the Trial Secretary's home.

The entry fee is \$14.00 per dog per class. This trial is pre-entry only; **no entries will be accepted at the show site.**

Follow the link to All About UKC; then the link to Forms.
- Use one entry form per dog.
- You **MUST** provide either a UKC registration number or temporary number. Otherwise the entry will be rejected. (Note, you can obtain a temporary number over the phone (616-343-9020) or on the web at [www.ukcdogs.com](http://www.ukcdogs.com). Points earned will be credited if a full registration is completed within 60 days of the points being earned.)
- Include an email address or an authorization to call collect. Otherwise, problems with the entry will be handled by postal mail.

### Jump Height Divisions

We assign divisions by the height of the dog. **No dog may jump higher than its assigned jump height.**

- Be sure to indicate the correct division for your dog:

Division I	Height at withers up to and <b>including</b> 14"
Division II	Greater than 14" up to and <b>including</b> 20"
Division III	Greater than 20"

- Ring Steward:** Sets bars to correct positions prior to each jump height class. Re-sets dropped bars, straightens the chutes.
- Gate Steward:** Checks off and calls exhibitors to the gate, in the correct order and ready to run.
- Leash Runner:** Takes the exhibitor's leash from the start line and places it at finish line.
- Timer:** Times the dog's run using a stopwatch.

## HOW TO USE THIS ENTRY FORM:

- All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC® Entry Form". You may use one entry form to enter the same dog in more than one activity on the same weekend.
- Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
- Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com or call the Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
- Mail all completed entry forms to the Event Secretary listed under the event, unless otherwise specified.
- Obedience Trials, Agility Trials, Rally Obedience Trials, Weight Pull events and Dog Sport Trial events are open to all UKC recognized breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Limited Privilege number.
- Obedience only: Check the box provided to request either the Veteran or Special Jump height option. Veteran dogs must be 8 years or older. Eligible dogs for Special Jump Heights are outlined in the current rules and regulations.
- Conformation classes consist of: Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Senior (2 yrs., under 3 yrs.); Adult (3 yrs. and up); Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Champion; and Grand Champion.
- Junior Showmanship classes consist of: Pee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.); Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 8 yrs.); Novice Junior, Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.); Novice Senior, Open Senior (13 yrs., under 18 yrs.)

**We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember.**

- All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Limited Privilege number.**
- All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
- To be eligible to enter into the Breeder/Handler class, you must be one of the breeders of record, or a member of the immediate family of one of the breeders of record. Immediate family includes: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, brother or sister.

## WAIVER

All events are held under the Official Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or firearms will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC Licensed event.
